Membership fees are as follows:

Single Membership - \$80

Family Membership - \$100

(When a driver turns 18 years of age they must join as a single member)

Family membership incorporates immediate family only i.e. Husband, wife or defacto relationship with children, only where children are under 18 years of age. When a driver turns 18 years they are required to join the club as a single member, unless they are studying and a valid student ID can be provided. Should this be unavailable at time of renewal, single membership will be charged and reimbursed on presentation of valid student ID.
